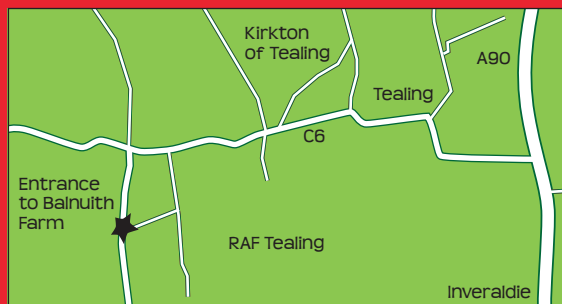


Rules

All exhibitors are assumed to have read these conditions and hereby agree to abide by them.

1. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes.
2. BSI Kitemark riding hats (PAS 015, BSEN 1384, ASTM F1163, SNELL E 2001) with secure chinstraps must be worn at all times when riding. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden Shetland pony classes.
3. Whips must not exceed 30" in length.
4. Stallions must not be ridden or led by juniors under the age of 16 years.
5. Exhibitors must ensure that horses/ponies are kept under control at all times.
6. Prepaid entry fee will be £3 per class or £5 if entered on the field. All cheques should be made payable to "Tealing Community Council". Only cash will be accepted on the day.
7. Exhibitors must have Public Liability Insurance.
8. The judge's decision is final.
9. Access to the field at the landowners discretion.

Ring 1 - Judging at 10am

Shetland Ponies Judge: To be confirmed

Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes.

Class 1 Brood Mare with foal at foot or yeld mare

Class 2 Foals shown with their dams
(NB foals must be 3 weeks old by show date)

Class 3 Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 4 2 or 3 year old Filly

Class 5 Stallion or Gelding – 2 years old and over

Shetland Championship (Classes 1-5)

Class 6 Miniature pony, 3 years old and under to mature at 34" or under including foals

Class 7 Miniature pony, 4 years old and over to mature at 34" or under, mare, stallion or gelding

Miniature Shetland Championship (Classes 6-7)

Class 8 Lead rein/ridden gelding or mare, 4 years and over.

Class 9 Young handler under 16 years. No stallions or colts to be show by anyone 14 years and under.

Mountain and Moorland Judge: To be confirmed

Small Breeds – Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Sections A&B

Large Breeds – New Forest, Fell, Dales, Connemara, Welsh Sections C&D, Highland

Class 10 In hand small part/pure bred, any age

Class 11 In hand large part/pure bred, any age

Class 12 Ridden small part/pure bred, 4 years old and over

Class 13 Ridden large part/pure bred, 4 years old and over

Mountain and Moorland Championship (Classes 10-13)

Ponies Judge: To be confirmed

Class 14 Junior Turnout. In hand/ridden pony not to exceed 14.2hh. Riders/handlers will be 16 years and under and will be judged on cleanliness and turnout of the horse, rider, tack and overall appearance.

Class 15 Riding pony in hand, colt, filly or gelding up to 3 years old not to exceed 14.2hh at maturity.

Class 16 Riding pony in hand, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over not to exceed 14.2hh at maturity.

Pony Championship (Classes 15-16)

Ring 2 - Judging at 10am

Horses Judge: To be confirmed

Class 17 Senior Turnout. In hand/ridden horse exceeding 14.2hh. Riders/handlers will be aged 17 years and over and will be judged on cleanliness and turnout of the horse, rider, tack and overall appearance.

Class 18 In hand horse, any age, to exceed 14.2hh and over at maturity

Class 19 Ridden Hunter, aged 4 years and over, must exceed 14.2hh, individual show

Class 20 Riding Horse, aged 4 years and over, must exceed 14.2hh, individual show

Class 21 Ridden Horse, aged 4 years and over, must exceed 14.2hh, individual show

Horse Championship (Classes 17-21)

Coloured Horses/Ponies Judge: To be confirmed

Class 22 In Hand Native, any age

Class 23 In Hand Non Native, any age, plaited and trimmed

Class 24 Ridden Native, 4 years old and over, any height

Class 25 Ridden Non Native, 4 years old and over, any height, plaited and trimmed

Coloured Championship (Classes 22-25)

Veteran Judge: To be confirmed

No spurs, galloping or wearing of jewellery permitted.

Class 26 In Hand Veteran, open to any horse or pony aged 15 years plus

Class 27 Ridden Veteran, open to any horse or pony aged 15 years plus

Veteran Championship (Classes 26-27)

Overall Supreme Champion of Show

– open to all individual section Champions
(to be judged at the end of the show).
