Special thanks to David Roulston for the wonderful live music throughout and to community councillor Hilda Young and her marvellous team of volunteer helpers for making it happen.


COMMUNITY COUNCIL ELECTIONS (Every 4 years)

School is now closed for the summer holiday and reopens for pupils on Tuesday 16 Aug.




SEAGREEN SUBSTATION AT TEALING UPDATE

This year should see the works at the Seagreen Tealing substation completed. The new buildings are up and the main focus has now moved towards reinstatement and planting in the areas surrounding the site, plus reinstatement and upgrade works along the Moatmill access Road from the A90. The substation will convert the voltage from the offshore windfarm (from 220kv to 275kv) across three circuits and export it to the electricity grid at the existing Tealing Substation.

When complete Seagreen Offshore Wind Farm project will be Scotland's largest and the world's deepest offshore wind farm and will provide enough power for over 1.6m homes (equivalent to two-thirds of all Scottish homes), placing Tealing at the heart of the renewables industry in Scotland. Works are going well offshore and the first power is due in the coming weeks. Full power is programmed for mid-2023.



Following on from the funding for the new Obstacle Course at Tealing Primary School we are pleased to be in the process of donating a number of our wooden cable drums to local schools. We are also excited to share our STEM presentation into the local schools once the new term begins too.



BISHOP "TED" LUSCOMBE 1924 – 2022

We are saddened to hear of the passing of great friend to Tealing, Ted Luscombe who died on 3 May. Ted and his beloved wife Doris came to live in Tealing when he retired from the church in 1990 and he was active for many years supporting local groups, the school and the community council.
