take any of this forward. There may also be a public event in the hall on Sat 2 March to discuss what options emerge from the survey. Look out for more information nearer the time.




## HALL FUTURE RESEARCH

Community Councillor Hilda has been testing out the new "demand responsive" bus service provided by Angus Council as a pilot in our area – and has been very impressed. She said "this service has proved to be a godsend to myself and many others. I no longer have to walk 10 minutes to a bus stop or cross the A90 on my way home from Dundee.

Booking the bus is so straightforward. I just phone 07584 206124 with the date and time that I need a bus. The staff organising the travel have gone out of their way to accommodate my needs and I've not ever been let down by the service. I'm picked up from and returned to my home address and have been dropped off at the Wellgate Centre and also on Arbroath Road when I needed to connect to Broughty Ferry. My return pick-up point has always been the top of Crichton Street. I urge local residents to give this service a try as it's so easy and convenient. I personally cannot praise it enough."
