### **MAKING PROGRESS**

Though it's still early days, we're making really good progress on several fronts now and others are starting to notice the new energy in Tealing. We were invited to present the story of setting up the development trust at the recent Community Development Conference at the Reid Hall in Forfar to more than 100 delegates organised by Angus Council with Angus Rural Partnership (ARP). Communities from all across Angus agreed to work together more to share learning and best practice. It was really refreshing to see the level of interest in locals leading the way in their own communities.

### **PARKS & GRFFN SPACES**

We're now actively working with the council parks department on the feasibility and affordability of potential improvements to Inveraldie Park. Particularly around things that might make it more accessible and easier to use for all age groups like a hard perimeter path, more seating for rest stops, a pavilion or shelter with seating to enjoy the view over the Sidlaws, some new play equipment, outdoor exercise machines and landscaping with raised beds etc.

### PATHS NETWORK CONSULTATION

Last year's resident's survey revealed a strong desire amongst many of you for some safe off-road paths for active travel and to better connect key places in Tealing on both sides of the A90. Angus Council officers and the support team at Paths for All have advised us to consult in more depth with local walkers to find out about your priorities. Look out for an online survey soon and a public meeting at the hall in the new year on this topic.

### **HALL FUTURE -TOP TEAM APPOINTED!**

Angus Rural Partnership is generously funding a project

to look at the options for ensuring the long-term future of the hall and, after a competitive tender, Alan Jones Associates were appointed and will report their costed recommendations in February. The team at AJA have successfully transformed more than 50 community halls throughout

# DEMAND RESPONSIVE BUS SERVICE (DIAL-A-BUS) NO. 539 – FREE SERVICE

On Wednesday 8th Nov we hosted a public meeting to discuss the new bus service. In attendance were Hilda and Chris of TCC; Ian Leith and Sharon Bennett from the Angus Council Transport Team and 15 local residents. The transport team explained that the number 139 bus service was being terminated by Stagecoach leaving us only with the buses that travel on the A90 for getting to and from the city. Angus Council has decided to trial a Demand Responsive Bus Service and Tealing is the chosen pilot area.

Meeting attendees were extremely positive regarding the new service. To access it you book your journey by calling 07584 206124 between the hours of 09:00 and 15:00 Monday to Friday and you must book at least the day before travel. There is no set route for the service. The bus will usually collect users near their home address. There is more information on the Angus council website and the Tealing Facebook pages. There will also be leaflets explaining the service available locally. Also, if you call the above mobile number someone will be able to answer any queries. The service started on Monday 13th Nov and comments so far have been positive, so hopefully the scheme will go from strength to strength.
